ABDOMINAL SONOGRAPHY (F)

LIVER: is enlarged, appears normal in echopattern. No focal mass lesion seen. No dilated IHBR seen. PV and CBD appears normal in size.

SPLEEN: appears normal in size and echopattern. No focal mass lesion seen.

GALL BLADDER: shows small calculus. No changes of cholecystitis or mass lesion seen.

PANCREAS: appears normal in size and echopattern. No evidence of focal mass lesion or changes of pancreatitis seen.

BOTH KIDNEYS: appears normal in size and echopattern. No evidence of calculus or hydronephrosis or mass lesion seen involving either kidney.

No ascites or lymphadenopathy seen.

URINARY BLADDER: appears normal. No intrinsic lesion seen.

Uterus and both adnexae appears normal. No evidence of uterine or ovarian mass lesion seen.

Bilateral pleural effusion seen.

COMMENT: HEPATOMEGALY. GB CALCULUS. BILATERAL PLEURAL EFFUSION.

ADVISE: Clinical co-relation and further investigation.

SONOGRAPHY ABDOMEN WITH PELVIS

LIVER : appears normal in size and echotexture. No evidence of focal or diffuse lesion. No evidence of dilated IHBR. PV and CBD appear normal in calibre.

GALL BLADDER : appears normal. No intrinsic lesion seen.

PANCREAS : appears normal in size and echotexture. No focal mass lesion or changes of pancreatitis seen.

SPLEEN : appears normal in size and echotexture. No evidence of focal or diffuse lesion.

BOTH KIDNEYS : appear normal in size and echotexture with preservation of corticomedullary differentiation. No evidence of calculus, hydronephrosis or mass lesion involving either kidney.

RK:8.2 X 4.0 cm LK:9.1 X 4.5 cm

URINARY BLADDER : appears normal. No intrinsic lesion seen.

UTERUS : is anteverted and appears normal in size(6.9 X 3.0 X 2.9 CM)and echotexture. Total endometrial thickness is 7 mm. Both adnexal regions are unremarkable. No evidence of ovarian mass lesion seen. No evidence of free fluid in the POD.

No evidence of ascites or paraaortic lymphdenopathy.

CONCLUSION :

NO EVIDENT ABNORMALITY DETECTED.
